Acuras have one of the longest intervals for timing belt replacement. Most models, like those with 3.2-liter engines, do not need their timing belt replaced until they hit 92,000 miles or after six years, whichever comes first. Others can go as long as 105,000 miles before the belt has to be replaced.

How to Know When to Replace Your Timing Belt

By definition a timing belt is a toothed belt that connects the camshaft or shafts to the crankshaft thus "timing"the top and bottom of the engine. The camshafts turn at exactly 1/2 of the speed of the crankshaft to time the valve operation to the piston operation.

Unless the timing belt breaks, most car owners forget about the existence of the belt, let alone the need to replace it. The best time to replace the belt is on your manufacturer's recommended change interval (usually between 50,000 and 100,000 miles), even if it looks in good condition.
