Captive breeding programs, however, have produced Budgies in almost every color of the rainbow, except red and pink.

Budgie Parakeet Colors, Varieties, Mutations, Genetics

Colony breeding involves setting up several pairs in a large flight. The flight should be about 6' L x 3' W x 4' H, with wire spacing of no more than one-half inch. You should provide a nest box for each pair, plus one extra nest box to prevent fighting, and all the nest boxes should be hung at the same height near the top of the enclosure.

Breeding / Nesting Most breeding activities occur during the rainy seasons - when their favorite food source - grass seeds - is most abundant. In northern Australia, this is between June and September (winter); and in southern parts between August and January (spring and summer). However, they will breed at any time of the year after heavy rains.

They need 10 to 12 hours of daylight, plenty of water, lots of the proper foods, and a good nesting area. Provide some type of material in the nesting box such as shredded paper or large pine shavings so the eggs won't roll around. Allow the birds to make changes to the nesting area as they see fit.

Breeding Your Parakeet - Parakeet Secrets

Breeding two yellow-based budgies who are split for white-base can result in white-based budgies. However, it is difficult to tell if a budgie is split for white-base. It is said that if there is blue in the feathers around the vent of a normal yellow-based budgie, it is split for white-base.
