Place one word at each end. If you start with one word, supply an antonym or a word connoting an opposite concept. Have students identify synonyms for both words Students who do not understand the original word will chime in as they hear words in their listening vocabulary. Guided oral reading—reading out loud while getting guidance and feedback from skilled readers. The combination of practice and feedback promotes reading fluency. Teaching vocabulary words—teaching new words, either as they appear in text or by introducing new words separately. This type of instruction also aids reading ability.
