Crimes can also be viewed as arrayed along a victimization continuum and divided into three crime categories: (1) crimes for which there is an obvious intended victim (e.g., murder and rape), (2) crimes in which victimization is the result of carelessness (e.g., negligent manslaughter), and (3) crimes in which participation in the crime is voluntary (e.g., prostitu- tion, drug offenses).
