The idea of the whole determining the meaning of the constituent part makes the context principle a part of semantic holism. Semantic holism is a linguistic principle that believes the meanings of sentences and words are derived from a wider context.

What Is the Context Principle?

In the philosophy of language, the context principle is a form of semantic holism holding that a philosopher should "never ... ask for the meaning of a word in isolation, but only in the context of a proposition" (Frege [1884/1980] x).

Just as the principle of classification applies to Art. 14 so it does to Art. 15(1) as well. The combined effect of Art.14 and 15 is not that the state cannot pass unequal laws, but if it does pass unequal laws, the inequality must be based on some reasonable ground (Art. 14), and that, due to Art.

15(1), religion, race, caste, sex, or place of birth alone is not, and cannot be, a reasonable ground for discrimination.
