Alternatively you can always install the stack on a different Oracle Home, which I never tried earlier. Select "Forms and Reports Deployment", as the last two versions of Forms & Reports allow you to install a Standalone Forms Builder. Select the correct JDK Home

### **Install Oracle forms & reports 12.2.1.4 with Weblogic 12c ...**

Oracle Forms 12c allows a Standalone Forms Builder installation, which no longer needs a WebLogic Installation. The standalone installation does not allow forms to be run, just built and compiled. To run them, they must be deployed to a full installation of Oracle Forms and Reports Services. There is no standalone equivalent of Oracle Reports.

The following conventions are used in this installation guide: "6i" refers to Oracle Forms Developer and Reports Developer Release 6i. oradev6 is the UNIX account owner of the 6i files.

### **How to Install (Configure) Oracle Fusion Middleware 11g R1 ...**

This article describes the silent installation of Oracle Forms and Reports on Oracle Linux 6. The article assumes there is already an Oracle WebLogic Server 11gR1 (10.3.6) installation present on the machine. Normal WebLogic installations can use either a Java6 or Java7 JDK as both are supported. If your WebLogic installation is for use with Oracle Forms, you must use a Java6 JDK, like JRockit.
