Perinatal Outcome In 1515 Cases

Measures of perinatal outcome were determined in relation to the duration of the second stage of labour . Of the 1515 neonates, 77 (5.1%) had a five-minute Apgar score < 7, 36 (2.4%) were admitted to the NICU, and 10 (0.7%) had confirmed or suspected seizures.

During the study period, 1515 women met the inclusion criteria. The majority of women (67%) delivered vaginally, after up to 10 hours in the second stage of labour The overall rate of Caesarean section was low (15.7%). The rate of permanent neurologic impairment was 2.6 per 1000 deliveries.

Umbilical cord arterial pH is one of the best predictors of perinatal adverse outcomes [23,24], and the threshold pH for adverse neurological outcomes is 7.10 . The Apgar score describes the condition of the newborn infant immediately after birth and, when properly applied, it is a tool for standardised assessment.

Perinatal outcome was survival at 28 days after birth. RESULTS: Between 1 January 2005 and 31 December 2010, 1950 pregnant women carrying 2151 fetuses underwent a total of 2828 FEs. Van Vliet et al. recently published, that in women with threatened preterm birth, 48 h of tocolysis with nifedipine or atosiban resulted in similar perinatal outcomes . However, more cases of intrauterine fetal demise (IUFD) were registered in the nifedipine group (5% vs. 2% in the atosiban group; RR 2.20, 95% CI 0.91-5.33, n.s.).
