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State Residential Care and Assisted Living Policy: 2004 ...

Assisted living facilities—also known as congregate housing, residential care, adult congregate care, boarding home, or domiciliary care—are suitable for individuals who need minimal daily care. In terms of medical needs, minimal care might be considered assistance with medication or intermittent skilled nursing care.

Adult Care Facilities/Assisted Living. Adult Care Facilities (ACF) provide long-term, non-medical residential services to adults who are substantially unable to live independently due to physical, mental, or other limitations associated with age or other factors.

Adult Care Facilities/Assisted Living - New York State ...

Enhanced adult residential care (EARC) is a package of services provided by an assisted living facility that is licensed under Chapter 18.20 RCW and that has a contract with the department to provide personal care services, intermittent nursing services, and medication administration services in accordance with Parts I and III of Chapter 388-110 WAC.

What is the difference between ARC, EARC, and AL contracts ...

Residential Care Facilities (Assisted Living) provide accommodation and personal care services primarily to older adults. These facilities are licensed and regulated by the Bureau of Regulatory Operations at the Ohio Department of Health. A residential care facility is licensed to provide either of the following:

Residential Care Facilities - Assisted Living

Residential or Assisted Housing services include any facility or residence licensed by the Maine Division of Licensing and Certification that provides necessary assistance such as personal care, meals, medication management, lodging, and supervision.

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Residential Care Services RCS is responsible for the licensing and oversight of adult family homes, assisted living facilities, nursing facilities, intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities, and certified community residential services and supports.

Residential Care or Assisted Living Facilities for the elderly/seniors include any facility or residence, however named, operated on either a profit or non-profit basis for the purpose of providing necessary supervision, personal assistance, meals, and lodging to three or more elderly adults not related to the owner.

Alzheimer's residential care throughout New York, sometimes called Memory Care, adds approximately \$837 - \$1,170 to the monthly cost of assisted living.
