Walking Bass for Jazz and Blues - Fundamental Changes ...

The bass lines are good and one simple addition to know is that just about ANY chord/walking bass line, you can always use a leading tone (that is, 1/2 step below) to WHATEVER is the next chord: so, if you are playing D minor for 4 beats, then the next chord (say is a G7), you simply play an F# on the fourth beat.

#1: Walking bass lines helps us learn and reinforce the fundamentals of jazz harmony. Jazz is an inherently harmonically complex style of music. As jazz musicians, we spend a lot of our practice time trying to learn to think, hear, and play our way through complicated chord progressions as improvisers.

How to Practice Walking Bass Lines for All Jazz ...

While walking bass in a band is generally played by the bass guitar or double bass player, being able to play walking bass lines is an essential skill for jazz guitarists when playing without a bass player. The difficulty in walking bass on the guitar lies in the combination of playing chords and bass at the same time.

The goal of a walking bass-line is to outline the chord progression but with an interesting melodic line that provides a counter-melody (as above). In Jazz, bass-lines should generally not be too repetitive (unless you're intentionally playing a vamp - like in Blues or Boogie-woogie). Walking bass-lines make wide use of:

C Blues Scale 8th Note Exercise Over A Walking Bass Line Turnaround Progression for Jazz Piano As you can see, we have 2 notes in the right hand for every 1 note in the left hand. Practice this scale up and down, and work to get this to 130BPM. Once you have this, it's time to work on creating lines!

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
